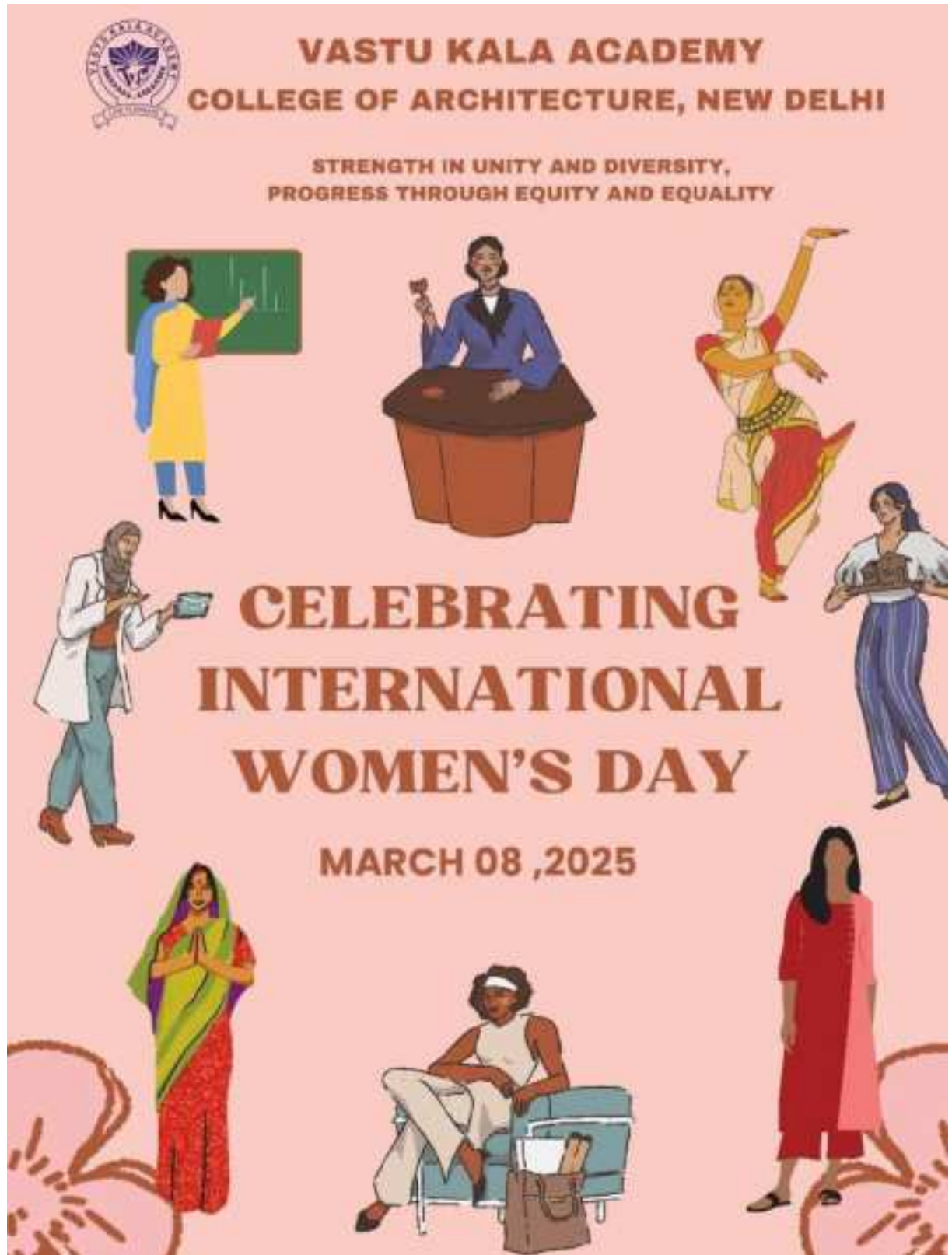

## Workshop Structure

Topic of Session	Objective
Healthy Relationships	The health of a relationship depends on the health of the individuals in it. The session will explore what lies in the foundation of our relationships - Are they founded upon dependence? Are they a refuge from our loneliness? or whether they are actually based on care and love?
Peaceful Living	The session will examine the relationship between peace and our everyday life and explore how we tend to mistake sensory gratification for peace. The workshop on 'Peaceful Living' aims to enquire with the participants whether we are living peacefully at all, or we are constantly riding on the see saw of pleasure and pain.
Psychological Maturity	The workshop on 'Psychological Maturity' aims at developing introspective skills in students and invites them to enquire whether their actions in life come from a point of self awareness or are merely a result of a compulsion or pressure exerted by their environment.
Decision Making	The confusion we face when we have to choose between different options comes from the absence of clarity within. The objective of the session will be to facilitate the students to make well informed decisions by understanding the inner system through which they currently take all their decisions from.
Time Management	The tendency to waste one's time is not the problem of time but the problem of the mind. The session will enquire into the difference between time by the clock and time that runs in the mind - and what is the internal criteria that we unconsciously use to allocate the time we spend on the things we do throughout the day.
Health Progress	The aim of the session will be to examine the common notions that are indicative of progress. The objective is to enquire how much the indicators that we associate with progress - acquiring intellectual acumen, wealth, technological advancement, contributes to the real progress of a human being.
Work-Life Balance	The session aims to understand whether there can be harmony between the life we live and the work we do, and if it is all necessary to get one against the other. The objective is to explore if there can be an integrated state of mind which does not become a victim of the conflict between work and life?
Self Improvement	The objective of the session is to understand what do we mean by self improvement, and whether there can be any improvement at all without understanding what the 'self' is. The aim is to enquire how we begin impose ourselves on the parameters given to us by our surroundings, not realizing what we actually need.

### 1. Event objectives-

Most young students of architecture may not have much exposure to deep theorization; as such participating in the LIK trophy could be an opportunity to hone the analytical skills. To compliment what the college has taught, it is worth reading books, listening to talks in the internet and discussing with eminent creative thinkers.

### 2. Event description:

Students can select any building of any functional or stylistic typology, from the pre-independence period. It could be in active use now or even abandoned, but should have the original design and construction intact. There could be some alterations, as long as the original character of the structure is intact. The minimum built up area should be more than 1000 sqm., just to ensure there could be adequate elements and complexities worthy of studying.

Documentation as per the normal LIK trophy expectations is mandatory. However, next step can be to analyze the architecture for its source of design, relevance to the context, meanings of the images and its tangible and intangible expressions. The critical challenge however, is to document not just the elements of design but understand and communicate the fundamental, essential, original and the elemental in architecture.

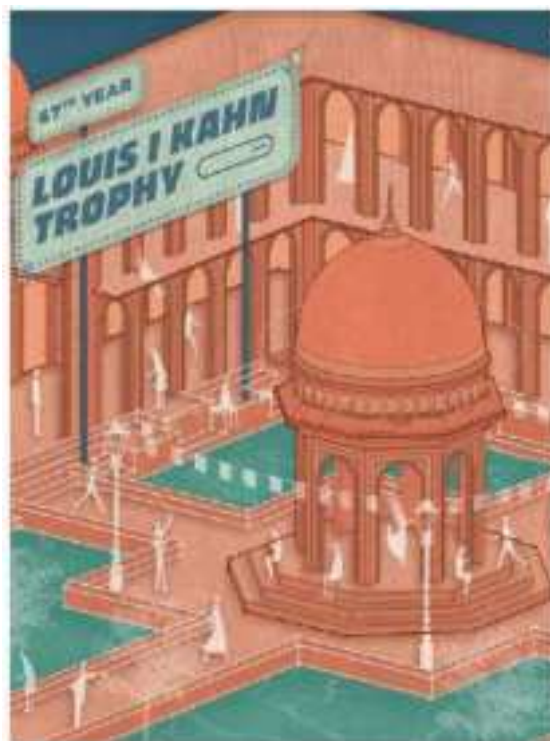
